NEWS UPDATES

Road Closure: As you will all have no doubt noticed the main access road known as “The Grange” has been closed as it finally gets resurfaced! Diversions are in place for the three week shutdown.

Safety Barriers/Fence Posts: No the Grange is not being used as a motorway slip road – the barriers are being put in place to protect us from the rather large ditches which are on the other side of the fence line. As no-one has yet to actually drive through the fences and into the ditches we are questioning the need for these barriers. They will also be painted green to “blend in” with the surrounding environment. There also large fence posts that have been erected on the opposite side of the Grange. These are not going to be fenced – they are demarcation posts to show which parts the Council and RMG are each responsible for. You can be assured we are questioning Bovis and RMG over these rather unsightly additions to our country idyll.
